AB12 Irwin (D) Gun Violence: Restraining Orders

Requires a court to consider the length of time that the threat of personal injury is likely to continue, for all gun violence restraining orders. Authorizes a person subject to such order to submit a request for a hearing to terminate the restraining order.

AB18 Levine (D) Firearms: Excise Tax

Imposes an excise tax on the sales of handguns and semiautomatic rifles and requires the revenue collected from that tax to be used to fund grants through the CalVIP program.

AB61 Ting (D) Gun Violence Restraining Orders

Authorizes an employer, a coworker, or an employee of a secondary or postsecondary school that the person has attended in the last 6 months to file for an ex parte, one-year, or renewed gun violence restraining order.

AB 164 Cervantes (D) Firearms: Prohibited Persons

Allows California to use any prohibited person restraining order issued by another state to justify making a person in California a prohibited person in California (including the prohibition from owning or possessing a firearm.)

AB 276 Friedman (D) Firearms: Storage

Requires all persons to securely store all their firearms against theft or unauthorized access. In accordance with a device that is listed on the Department of Justice's roster of approved firearm safety devices.

AB340 Irwin (D) Firearms: Armed Prohibited Persons

Authorizes creation of a Disarming Prohibited Persons Taskforce team program, for the purpose of, among other things, identifying, monitoring, arresting, and assisting in the prosecution of individuals who are armed and prohibited from possessing a firearm.

AB 503 Flora (R) Gun-Free School Zone

Exempts valid CCW holder from school zone firearm restrictions if the person has the written permission of the school authority and subject to specified conditions.

AB 569 Fong (R) False Reports: Active Shooter Situations

Broadens provisions and penalties for those who make concerning false bomb threats and active shooter situations is underway.

AB 688 Chu (D) Firearms: Vehicle Storage

Requires all firearms stored in a vehicle to be secured to the vehicle frame by a steel cable lock, chain and padlock or in a locked container.

AB 879 Gipson (D) Firearms

Requires the sale of firearm parts to be conducted by or processed through a licensed firearm vendor. Category: 2019_Legislation Position: **Oppose Priority: High**

AB 997 Low (D) Firearms: Persons Detained or Apprehended

Prohibits a person who has been detained or apprehended for examination of their mental condition from possessing a firearm or deadly weapon pending the hearing . Prohibits firearm possession for 5 years if court determines would likely endanger others.

AB 1064 Muratsuchi (D) Firearms Dealers: Conduct of Business

Imposes a fine of up to \$ 3,000 for firearm dealers who have breached existing firearm laws.

AB 1096 Melendez (R) Firearms: Concealed Carry Licenses

Requires issuance of a CCW or open carry license if good cause exists and the applicant is of good moral character. (self-defense, defending the life of another, or preventing crime in which human life is threatened.)

AB 1121 Bauer-Kahan (D) Firearms: Prohibited Persons

Prohibits a person who is granted this pretrial diversion based on a mental health disorder from owning or possessing a firearm, or other dangerous or deadly weapon.

AB 1297 McCarty (D) Firearms: Concealed Carry License

Requires reasonable costs for processing CCW application, issuing the license, and enforcing the license. Category: 2019_Legislation Position:

AB 1559 Melendez (R) Firearms: Emergency Concealed Carry Permits

Authorizes a person to apply to the sheriff in the county in which they reside for a temporary emergency license to carry a concealed firearm when they are in immediate and grave danger of domestic violence, sexual assault, or stalking. : 2019_Legislation Position: **Support Priority: High**

AB 1602 Low (D) Use of Firearm Insurance

Prohibit an insurer from issuing or renewing a policy of insurance for a loss related to the use of a firearm, except for a policy that insures against liability for loss of or damage to property related to the use of a firearm or a commercial policy that insures a licensed firearms dealer against liability for, among other things, injury to or death of a person as a result of the theft, sale, lease, or transfer of a firearm or ammunition.

AB 1669 Bonta (D)

Firearms: Gun Shows and Events

Amends the Safety For All Act. Prescribes the rules and regulations for gun shows and events to be consistent with the sale of ammunition at gun shows and events as authorized by the Act.

AB 1746 Melendez (R)

Firearms: License to Carry Concealed

Authorizes law enforcement authorities to issue CCW upon proof that the person applying is of good moral character, that good cause exists.

SB 55 Jackson (D)

Firearms: Prohibited Persons

Adds to list of misdemeanors that allow prohibition from owning or having custody or control over a firearm within ten years after conviction . Includes those who have multiple convictions for alcohol intoxication or possession of controlled substances for sale.

AB 61 Portantino (D)

Firearms: Transfers

Provides that an existing law which makes it unlawful for a person to purchase more than one of specified firearms every 30 days, applicable to all types of firearms.

AB 172 Portantino (D)

Firearms

Requires firearm storage in one of certain specified ways, including in a gun safe or by using a firearm safety device. Exempts an unloaded antique firearm from those provisions.

SB 220 Hill (D)

Firearms Dealers: Storage and Security

Requires each of the firearms held by a firearms dealer to be secured by storing the firearm in a secure facility. These include a steel rod or cable, a safe, vault or other specified barriers on front entrance.

SB 281 Wiener (D)

Cow Palace Joint Powers Authority

Establishes the Cow Palace Authority for the purpose of managing, developing, or disposing of the real property known as the Cow Palace. Establish the governing board of the authority, comprised of members appointed by the Mayor of the City of Daly City, the Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco, and the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo.

SB 376 Portantino (D)

Firearms: Transfers

Redefines the word infrequent to mean less than six firearm transactions per calendar year, regardless of the type of firearm within regulations controlling transfers of firearms.

SB 701 Jones (R)

Firearms: Prohibited Persons

Relieves persons who have an outstanding warrant for a felony, or one of several specified misdemeanor to own or possess a firearm or ammunition.
