ACR 115 KAMLAGER-DOVE RESOLUTION LENDING TO GUN RELATED BUSINESSES

urge each bank with which the State of California *has a business relationship* to evaluate *its commercial relationship* with gun-*manufacturers and to* consider the repercussions of *that relationship*, and *urge all banks to* adopt lending practices that mirror the people of California's values of protecting citizens before profit.

FROM COMMITTEE. BE ADOPTED . **3 /10 ... ORDERED TO THIRD READING NO DATE SET YET**

AB 2061 LIMON FIREARMS: INSPECTIONS

This bill would allow the Department of Justice to inspect firearms dealers, ammunition vendors, or manufacturers participating in a gun show or event in order to ensure that all transfers or sales are conducted in compliance with applicable state and local laws. The bill would also allow the department to inspect ammunition vendors to ensure compliance with applicable state and federal laws. The bill would allow the department to adopt regulations to administer the application and enforcement of laws relating to gun shows and ammunition vendors.

3/10 REFERRED TO ASSEMBLY COMTE ON APPROPRIATIONS

AB 2235 Gabriel GUN VIOLENCE RESTRAINING ORDERS .

Authorizes a peace officer to issue a temporary emergency gun violence restraining order on an ex parte basis only if a law enforcement officer asserts, and a judicial officer finds, that there is reasonable cause to believe the person : (1) poses an immediate and present danger of causing personal injury to *themselves* or another by having custody or *control of, or* owning, purchasing, possessing, or *receiving*, a firearm or ammunition. (2)(b) shall prohibit the subject of the petition from having custody or *control of, or* owning, purchasing, possessing, or receiving, or attempting to purchase or receive, a firearm or ammunition, and shall expire 21 days from the date the order is issued.

STILL AWAITING COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENT .

AB 2352 IRWIN FIREARMS: GUN VIOLENCE RESTRAINING ORDERS

Adds District Attny to the list of people authorized to petition the court to issue an order restraining a person from possessing a firearm, as specified, or to petition the court for the renewal of such an order. Mandates that Dist. Attny notify Dept of Justice of any threat of physical violence reported by a psychotherapist.

ASSBY COMTE ON PUB SAFETY HEARING POSTPONED ON 3/17 NO HEARING DATE SET

AB 2358 PETIRE - NORRIS FIREARMS: RETURN OF CUSTODY

Bill would make it easier to have firearms which do not have a serial number to be categorized as an antique and returned to owner

ASSBY COMTE ON PUB SAFETY HEARING POSTPONED ON 3/17 NO HEARING DATE SET

AB 2617 FRIEDMAN FIREARMS PROHIBITED PERSONS

Prohibits a person subject to a public restraining order from any state to have a firearm or ammunition for a period of five years.

ASSBY COMTE ON PUB SAFETY HEARING POSTPONED ON 3/17 NO HEARING DATE SET

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AB 2753 EGGMAN DOJ INFORMATION SYSTEM FIREARMS VIOLATIONS

Enable law enforcement to determine the likely presence of a firearm or ammunition through a California Law Enforcement Telecommunications System, before commencing an investigation regarding whether a violation of a firearm prohibition exists.

ASSBY PUB SAF COMTE WAS SCHEDULED FOR HEARING AS SOON AS MARCH 22ND BUT NO UPDATE FOUND.

AB 3071 MULLIN LEAD AMMO SHOOTING RANGES BAN.

Would prohibit a sport shooting range or an indoor shooting range, from selling or giving away ammunition unless that ammunition is certified as nonlead ammunition by the commission. The bill would also prohibit patrons or employees of a sport shooting range or an indoor shooting range from firing ammunition unless it is nonlead certified.

BILL HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN BY AUTHOR

AB 3127 MCCARTY FIREARMS: REPORTS TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES

Commencing Jan 1, 2022, require the DOJ to notify the relevant local law enforcement agency of each 1) application to purchase a firearm, 2) request to register the acquisition or ownership of a firearm, 3) request to obtain a serial number for a firearm, 4) request to register an assault weapon or .50 BMG rifle, and 5) request for specified weapons permits. Commencing January 1, 2025, the bill would also require the department to notify the relevant local law enforcement agency of each request to purchase a firearm precursor part.

REFERRED TO ASSBY COMTE PUB SAFTY ON 3 / 9 NO HEARING DATE SET

SR 61 BEAL, ET AL RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO GUN VIOLENCE.

Resolved by the Senate of the State of California, 1) That a federal assault weapons ban be passed by Congress to protect all Americans from senseless gun violence; and 2) a comprehensive federal approach by the United States Senate to reducing and preventing gun violence is needed to protect Second Amendment rights .

BILL RE-INTRODUCED AFTER FAILING IN 2019. SENATE PUB SAFETY COMTE. HEARING POSTPONED ON 1/14... NO DATE SET FOR REVIEW

SB 220 HILL FIREARMS DEALERS STORAGE AND SECURITY

Requires each of the firearms held by a firearms dealer to be secured by storing the firearm in a secure facility. Requires the firearms to additionally be secured using one of several methods including the method involving a steel rod or cable or the method involving a safe or vault. Requires street level storage facilities using the rod or cable method to install, or cause to be installed, concrete or hardened steel bollards meeting certain specifications, or other specified barriers on front entrance.

BILL PLACED IN INACTIVE FILE IN 2019. SCHEDULED TO BE RE-INTRODUCED ON ASSBY FLOOR BUT NO DATE SET.

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SB897 JACKSON GUN VIOLENCE RESTRAINING ORDER ;

Would require the law enforcement officer to file a copy of the order with the court as soon as practicable, but not later than 3 days, after issuance . Existing legislation only requires filing copy of order as soon as practical.

SEN COMTE PUB SAFETY: ON 3/18 HEARING WAS POSTPONED. NO NEW HEARING DATE SET AS YET.

SB 941 PORTANTINO DEPT. OF JUSTICE : FEES

This bill would delete obsolete provisions relating to the department's authority to impose fees for nonelectronic transfers of firearm purchaser information to the department.

SEN. PUB SAFETY COMTE. HEARING HAS BEEN POSTPONED WITH NO NEW HEARING DATE SET AS YET.

SB 955 PORTANTINO RECREATIONAL AND ORGANIZATIONAL REGULATIONS

This bill would **impose specified requirements on specific camp activities** including, among others, **riflery, archery**, horseback riding, climbing, swimming, and scuba diving. The bill would require each camp to obtain specified certifications before offering high-risk activities. Would authorize a local agency to charge an application fee in a specified amount. Would require the local agency to inspect a camp for compliance with these provisions before issuing a license to operate.

SEN HEALTH COMITTEE HEARING POSTPONED WITH NO NEW HEARING DATE SET AS YET.

SB 1061 MONNING FIREARMS SURRENDERS TO LAW ENFORCEMENT

Require a law enforcement agency, to accept and dispose of any found, unwanted, or inherited firearm turned in by any person. Would additionally require the law enforcement agency to adopt a policy regarding accepting surrendered firearms and to post that policy and other specified information on its internet website. Would require the Department of Justice to develop information and guidelines regarding the surrendering of firearms and to post that information on its internet website. Exempts person surrendering a firearm pursuant to these provisions from specified requirements relating to the possession and transfer of a firearm.

SEN PUB SAFETY COMTE: MARCH 31 HEARING POSTPONED . NO NEW DATE SET YET.
