

SUMMARY OF PENDING GUN LEGISLATION IN SACRAMENTO
6 14 21

AB 228 RODRIGUEZ Theft: receiving stolen property: firearms.

Under existing law, theft of any firearm, regardless of value, is grand theft and is punishable as a felony. **Would make knowingly buying or receiving a stolen firearm, as specified, regardless of the value of the firearm, punishable as either a misdemeanor OR a felony.**

6 14 21 IN ASMBLY PUB SAFETY COMTE HEARING REMAINS CANCELLED BY AUTHOR

AB 311 WARD Firearms: gun shows.

Prohibit a vendor at a **gun show** or event from **possessing, displaying, offering to sell, selling, or transferring any firearm precursor parts**. Misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$2,000. Bans convicted person from participating in any gun show or event in this state for one year after the date of the conviction. If violates gun show ban fine not to exceed \$5,000 and a 5-year prohibition on participating in any gun show or event in the state.

AB 452 FRIEDMAN Pupil safety: parental notification: firearm safety laws.

Would have state pay costs of schools to inform parents and guardians of pupils of California's child access prevention laws and laws relating to the safe storage of firearms, AB 667

6 14 21 IN ASSBY EDUCATION COMITEE SINCE 4/13 . STILL AWAITING NEW HEARING DATE

AB 667 IRWIN Firearms: Armed Prohibited Persons System.

Renames the Armed Prohibited Persons File. Require the department to add a person's information to the Armed Prohibited Persons System if they are the subject of specified gun violence restraining orders and possess a firearm.

6 14 21 ASSBY COMTE APPROPRIATIONS STILL HELD IN SUBMISSION,.... NO HEARING SET

AB 669 LACKEY Firearms: unsafe handguns

Exempts restrictions on sales of firearms not on safe handgun list to or purchases by a county probation department and sworn members thereof who have completed specified firearms training prescribed by POST.

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AB 681 RAMOS Mental health: information sharing.

Requires report be filed with Dept. of Health Care Services regarding **any person detained as a danger to others and banned from having a firearm** in addition to the Department of Justice .

5 23 21 IN ASSBY COMTE ON HEALTH SINCE FEB 13... NO HEARING DATE SET

AB 876 GABRIEL Law Enforcement

Require all handguns, with the exception of revolvers, as defined, purchased on or after July 1, 2023, that are owned, used, possessed, or otherwise carried by state, county, city, or other law enforcement officers while on duty to be micro-stamped within 90 days of purchase or acquisition.

AB 1057 PETRIE-NORRIS Firearms restraining orders

Bill expands the items to be confiscated from someone subject to a restraining order to include unfinished firearms or parts that could be assembled into a firearm.

AB 1223 LEVINE Firearms and ammunition: excise tax

Imposes an excise tax on a retailer in the amount of \$25 per firearm on the sale in this state of a handgun or semiautomatic rifle or shotgun sold as new, as provided, **and an excise tax on a retailer from any sale of ammunition.**

AB 1237 TING Information access: research institutions firearms

Requires the state to ensure all firearm violence data is made available to the California Firearm Violence Research Center at UC Davis.

6 14 21 IN ASSBY APPROPRIATIONS . HEARING POSTPONED ON 5/20

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AB 1509 LEE Enhancements: firearms

Reduces some felony gun crimes to as little as one year jail term.. even if someone is shot to death.

6 14 21 IN ASSBY APPROPRIATIONS . REMAINS HELD IN SUBMISSION ON 5/20

SB 264 MIN Firearms: state property.

Reimburses local agencies and school districts for certain costs related to gun buy back programs.

SB 320 EGGMAN Domestic violence protective orders: possession of a firearm.

For anyone subject to public restraining order, **requires law enforcement officials to take all actions necessary to obtain any firearms owned, possessed, or controlled and to address any violation of the restraining order** unless court has provided written record of said firearms being relinquished.

SB 715 PORTANTINO Criminal law

Prohibit the dealer from returning a firearm to the person making the sale, transfer, or loan, if that person is prohibited from obtaining a firearm. Prohibit the possession of a firearm, other than a handgun, by a minor.

SB 827 BRADFORD, ET AL Public Safety Omnibus

Bill would allow criminals to have past convictions reduced in accordance with legislation currently in effect under the Control, Regulate and Tax Adult Use of Marijuana Act.
